INTERSTATE 10 DESERT CENTER PAVEMENT REHABILITATION PROJECT

RIVERSIDE – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) continues work on the \$95 million Interstate 10 (I-10) Pavement Rehabilitation Project. The project will rehabilitate 124 lane miles of pavement in both directions of I-10 between Cactus City and State Route 177 (SR-177) junction.

For the next two weeks pavement work will be on westbound I-10 between the SR-177 junction and Cactus City Rest Area. The westbound I-10 will be down to **ONE** lane Monday through Friday.

The details of work for **October 24 to November 6, 2016** are as follows:
