CALTRANS CONTINUES WINTER PREP IN THE SAN BERNARDINO MOUNTAINS

SAN BERNARDINO - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) District 8 continues maintenance activities to prepare for the coming winter season on State Route 18 (SR-18). These activities include striping, tree trimming and removal, and general roadway maintenance. Below are the details of the scheduled work for the week of October 24th through October 28th:

On Monday and Tuesday from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., maintenance crews will be working on a small stretch of roadway on SR-18 (approximately 2/10 of a mile) for tree trimming and tree removal near Lake Gregory Drive. Since the work will require a full closure of the highway, traffic will be detoured on to North Road and Grand View.

On Wednesday and Thursday from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., maintenance crews will be working on State Route 138 (SR-138) with a 1-way traffic control. There is no detour necessary, but motorists should expect delays or avoid the route completely.

From Monday through Friday, motorists should anticipate delays for a moving closure necessary for striping from the junction of SR-18 and SR-138 to the junction of SR-18 and State Route 330 (SR-330).

Additional updates on these and other maintenance activities will be provided throughout the week.
