Interstate 10 Pavement Rehabilitation Project 2nd Revision – Update #28

Riverside County – Construction of the Interstate 10 Pavement Rehabilitation Project continues next week. Work includes paving, replacing panels, and striping. Ramps and lanes will be closed as needed within the **revised** dates and times shown below.
