## INTERSTATE 15 JOINT PORT OF ENTRY PROJECT TRUCK SCALE CALIBRATION

**SAN BERNARDINO/RIVERSIDE** – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) continues work on the Joint Port of Entry (JPOE) project on Interstate 15, just south of the Nevada and California State Line.

Beginning on October 26<sup>th</sup>, 2015, truck traffic will be rerouted through the new JPOE facility in order to calibrate the scales at the newly constructed Commercial Vehicle Enforcement Facility (CVEF) until mid-November. Approximately 150 semi-trucks must pass through the facility to calibrate the new equipment effectively. Our partners at the California Highway Patrol (CHP) will be diverting truck traffic to the JPOE facility for the duration of the testing. Truck traffic will be restored back to the I-15 mainline until the facility opens in early 2016.

Minimal impacts are expected for traffic on the mainline of I-15 during this process.
