BE WORK ZONE ALERT!

1-WAY TRAFFIC CONTROL CONTINUES ON STATE ROUTE 38 HATHAWAY CREEK BRIDGE PROJECT

SAN BERNARDINO – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) continues the bridge rehabilitation project on State Route 38 (SR-38) at Hathaway Creek Bridge near Barton Flats. The \$1.6 million will upgrade the pavement, bridge rails, and replace the bridge deck and approach slabs. Project benefits include improved access for increased truck traffic and new pavement with extended life requiring less maintenance. The project is expected to be complete in late 2015.

Motorists are advised that other roadwork exists on mountain routes to Big Bear. SR 18, which is under traffic control for paving from Rim Forest to Running Springs, in addition to **full** closure of SR 18 between Snow Valley Mountain Resort and the Big Bear Dam (Arctic Circle) through October 29 from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Caltrans asks motorists to plan ahead for the delays anticipated during the construction and maintenance work.
