## Interstate 10 Pavement Rehabilitation Project Revised Update #29

**Riverside County** – Construction of the Interstate 10 Pavement Rehabilitation Project continues next week. Work includes paving, replacing panels, and striping. Ramps and lanes will be closed as needed within the dates and times shown below.
