

74/215 INTERCHANGE PROJECT CONSTRUCTION ALERT

Date: Thursday, October 21, 2010

PERRIS – The Riverside County Transportation Commission and project partners continue constructing the 74-215 Interchange (also known as the 4th Street Interchange). Construction work to remove asphalt and the concrete barriers in the center median as well as the installation of drainage systems on Redlands Avenue east of the bridge will continue. Weather conditions have required additional closures to occur this week in addition to the regularly scheduled closures as follows, **weather permitting**:

Closure Activity	Closure Location	Date, Time and Details
Freeway lane closures	Southbound I-215 between Perris Boulevard Overcrossing & the temporary 4 th Street off-ramp	Friday nights, October 22 & 29 Lane closure will occur each night from 11 pm to 6 am the following morning. Monday through Thursday nights, October 25, 26, 27 & 28 Lane closure will occur each night from 9 pm to 5 am the following morning. One travel lane and temporary 4 th Street off-ramp will remain open during these closures.
Freeway lane closures	Northbound I-215 between the off ramp at 4 th Street and Perris Blvd Overcrossing	Friday nights, October 22 & 29 Lane closure will occur each night from 9 pm to 6 am the following morning. Monday through Thursday nights, October 25, 26, 27 & 28 Lane closure will occur each night from 8 pm to 4 am the following morning. One travel lane will remain open during these closures.
Ramp closures	Northbound I-215 off-ramp at 4th Street	Friday nights, October 22 & 29 Ramp closure will occur each night from 9 pm to 6 am the following morning. Monday through Thursday nights, October 25, 26, 27 & 28 Ramp closure will occur each night from 8 pm to 4 am the following morning. During these closures, motorists will be directed to use the Nuevo Road off-ramp.
Lane closures	Redlands Avenue from the north bound freeway ramps to San Jacinto Avenue	Monday through Friday nights, October 25, 26, 27, 28 & 29 Lane reduction will occur each night from 9 pm to 5 am the following morning. One travel lane will remain open during these closures. A flagging operation will be in place to direct motorists through the area.

The project will pave the way for better traffic flow, easier access to downtown Perris and improved connections to both north and south Interstate 215. The project will replace the current two-lane bridge over the freeway with an eight-lane bridge, realign freeway ramps, widen streets, replace stop signs with traffic signals, add a sidewalk north of the bridge and build residential sound walls. Throughout construction, please remember to **Slow for the Cone Zone!**
