DEVORE 2 – WEEKLY UPDATE

San Bernardino County – Caltrans continues the Devore 2 Pavement Rehabilitation project on Interstate 15 (I-15) near the junction of 15/215 in Devore. Most of the work will be completed at night; however, Caltrans has planned approximately five weekends of Rapid Rehab work. The Rapid Rehab weekend work schedule began October 6 and will continue on weekends throughout November. The schedule is subject to change. Next week's schedule is listed as follows:

Friday night to Saturday morning, October 27-28 and Saturday night to Sunday morning, October 28-29:

- ☞☞ One lane closed on northbound I-215 from Devore Rd. to 15/215 interchange from 8:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.
- ☞☞ One lane closed on northbound I-15 from Kenwood Ave. to Cleghorn Rd. from 11:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m.

Sunday, October 29 through Friday, November 3:

- ☞☞ North & southbound I-15 from Glen Helen Parkway to Cleghorn Rd. will be subject to intermittent lane closures from 6:00 p.m. to 7:00 a.m.
- ☞☞ The on & off-ramps at Sierra Avenue, Glen Helen Parkway and Kenwood Ave. are subject to closure intermittently from 6:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.
- ☞☞ The northbound I-15 connector to the southbound I-215 is subject to closure intermittently from 6:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m.
- ☞☞ Lanes will remain reduced (24 hours per day) on north and southbound I-15 from Glen Helen Pkwy. to Sierra Ave. (over the Lytle Creek Wash) until the end of November. Morning commuters are advised to add up to 45 minutes to their travel time to accommodate any delays.

The two most common reasons for crashes, injuries and fatalities in highway work zones are speeding and inattentive driving. Remember to watch out for cars slowing down ahead of you or changing lanes at the last minute. A little extra caution the highway work zone could save your own life.
