INTERSTATE 10 REDLANDS PAVEMENT REPLACEMENT PROJECT EMERGENCY REPAIR

SAN BERNARDINO – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) continues work on the \$26 million Interstate 10 (I-10) Pavement Replacement Project. The project replaces concrete pavement in both directions of I-10 between Ford Street in the City of Redlands and Live Oak Canyon Road in the City of Yucaipa.

TONIGHT between the hours of 9:00 p.m. to 4:00 a.m. the eastbound I-10 at Live Oak Canyon Road in the City of Yucaipa will be reduced to two (2) lanes for emergency pavement repair in the number three (3) lane.
