WHAT: UPDATE ON ROAD OPENINGS & CLOSURE

WHEN: SUNDAY, OCTOBER 28 2007 (1100)

WHERE: SAN BERNARDINO COUNTY

In cooperation with county fire authority and the sheriff’s department, Caltrans will open roads to the Lake Arrowhead area today, Sunday, October 28, at 12:00 p.m. Communities **west** of Sky Forest (SR-18 and Kuffel Canyon); Twin Peaks, Rim Forest, Blue Jay, Aguafia, Deer Lodge Peak, Sky Forest, and Cedar Glen will be open to residents. Passes and proof of residency is not required. Communities **east** of Sky Forest are still under mandatory evacuation. These communities are Running Springs, Arrow Bear and Green Valley Lake. Several local roads remain closed due to the extensive fire damage:

- Brentwood Drive @ Sonoma Drive
- San Benito Drive @ Pinehurst Drive
- Brentwood Drive @ Pinehurst Drive
- Brentwood Drive @ Oakmont Drive
- Brentwood Drive @ Grass Valley Drive

Fire Patrols will continue in the Lake Arrowhead area around the fire perimeters.
