Interstate 215 Emergency Roadwork Continues

San Bernardino – Caltrans emergency roadwork due to the fires on October 13 continues on Interstate 215. The contractor will be working on the north and southbound sides of the freeway from south of 2nd Street to Baseline Avenue. However, most of the work will be done on the northbound side of the freeway. At least one lane in each direction will be available at all times. The north and southbound on- and off-ramps at 2nd Street may also be closed intermittently.

Please allow extra time—especially during commute hours. To keep you moving and on time the most recent work schedule is shown below.
