UPDATE- STATE ROUTE 18 PAVING PROJECT

SAN BERNARDINO-The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) and Match Corporation continue the \$4 million paving project on State Route 18 (SR-18).

The paving project is currently in Running Springs. The current construction schedule is below. These dates and times may change based on weather or construction progress.

DATE	LIMITS OF WORK	HOURS
Mon., Nov. 2 & Tues., Nov. 3	Nob Hill Drive to the SR-330 (including downtown Running Springs)	9:00 a.m. to 5 p.m. No weekend work
Wed., Nov 4	Pine Ave., Rim Forest, to the SR-330 Install Center Line Rumble Strips	9:00 a.m. to 5 p.m. No weekend work
Thur., Nov. 5 & Fri., Nov. 6	Demobilizing pieces of equipment- expect intermittent delays	9:00 a.m. to 5 p.m. No weekend work

Advisory signs are posted stating that the project is approaching. **SLOW DOWN** as soon as you see the construction advisory signs. Expect delays.

Access to SR-18 is restricted until the hot asphalt has cooled sufficiently. Make parking arrangements outside of the construction zone if the project is in your area.

Avoid delays. Use SR-330 to the Big Bear area.

A paving project is underway on SR-38 and subject to traffic control from 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. until project completion.
