



INTERSTATE 215 CONSTRUCTION ALERT



CLOSURE ANNOUNCEMENTS

2nd Street Northbound Off-Ramp October 26-29 from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m.

The 2nd Street northbound off-ramp will be closed daily Monday, October 26 through Thursday, October 29 starting at 9 p.m. and will reopen daily at 5 a.m. Crews will clear and grub the project area, remove the existing curb and gutter, and prepare the ramp for temporary pavement. As a detour, drivers can continue north on I-215 and exit 5th Street, turn right onto G Street, and travel south to 2nd Street.

9th Street Bridge Starting Monday, November 2 at 6 a.m.

The 9th Street bridge will be closed beginning Monday, November 2 at 6 a.m. to be reconstructed as part of the overall project. The bridge will remain closed until late 2010. As a detour, drivers can travel north or south using H Street to the east and J Street to the west to access either Baseline or 5th Street to cross I-215.

4th Street Northbound and Southbound On-Ramps Starting Monday, November 2 at 9 p.m.

The 4th Street northbound and southbound on-ramps will be closed starting Monday, November 2 at 9 p.m. and close permanently. Crews will begin work to construct ramps that allow drivers to access I-215 directly from the 5th Street bridge, eliminating the current 4th Street on-ramps. As a detour, drivers can travel south on H/G Street and turn right at 2nd Street to enter northbound or southbound I-215.

SANBAG and Caltrans are hosting an **OPEN HOUSE** to inform the public about Phases 3 & 4 of the I-215 Widening Project. It will be held on **Tuesday, October 27, 4:30-7:00 pm**, at the Santa Fe Depot Lobby, 1170 W. 3rd Street, San Bernardino. Maps and three-dimensional models will be on display for the public to view and ask questions of project engineers and team members. All interested residents and businesses are encouraged to attend.
