BE WORK ZONE ALERT!

STATE ROUTE 38 HATHAWAY CREEK BRIDGE PROJECT UPDATE

SAN BERNARDINO – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) continues the bridge rehabilitation project on State Route 38 (SR-38) at Hathaway Creek Bridge near Barton Flats. The \$1.6 million will upgrade the pavement, bridge rails, and replace the bridge deck and approach slabs. Project benefits include improved access for increased truck traffic and new pavement with extended life requiring less maintenance.

Caltrans will open all lanes on SR-38 over Hathaway Creek on Monday, November 2, at approximately 3:00 p.m. One-way traffic control will no longer be necessary for the bridge rehabilitation operation.

Work will continue around and under the Hathaway Creek Bridge until the project is completed in late November or early December of this year. Lane closures will be minimal.

Motorists are advised that roadwork continues on mountain routes to Big Bear. Caltrans asks motorists to plan ahead for the delays anticipated during the planned construction and ongoing maintenance work.
