### **DEVORE 2 – WEEKEND WORK UPDATE**

#### **RAPID REHAB WEEKEND WORK FOR NOVEMBER 3 - 5**

**San Bernardino County** – Caltrans continues to make progress on the Devore 2 Pavement Rehabilitation project on Interstate 15 (I-15) near the junction of 15/215 in Devore, just south of the Cajon Pass. Night work will continue Monday through Sunday from 6 pm to 6 am.

**There will be Rapid Rehab weekend work this weekend.** The work will begin on Friday, November 3, at 9:00 a.m. and continue to Sunday, November 5, at 1:00 p.m. Reference the Closure B map on our website or brochure. Closure B involves two connectors and is as follows:

- Friday morning (9 am), November 3 to Sunday afternoon (1 pm), November 5:
- Southbound I-15 to southbound I-15 connector closed.
  - Northbound I-215 to southbound I-15 connector closed.

#### **(Southbound 15 connector closed)**

**Southbound I-15:** Take southbound I-215 towards San Bernardino to westbound I-10 and to reconnect with the I-15 in Ontario.

**Northbound I-15** – all lanes open to traffic

#### **(NB 215 connector to SB 15 closed)**

**Northbound I-215:** Take westbound I-10 to northbound I-15. If you miss this detour, your last chance exit is Devore Road. Otherwise you will be forced to turn around to access southbound I-15 and go through the construction zone. This could result in an additional 2-3 hour delay.

Caltrans plans to open the lanes on Sunday afternoon at 1 p.m. to accommodate the travelers coming back from Las Vegas. Please be aware that additional traffic at the interchange is anticipated. Caltrans has just been informed that a special memorial service will be held at the Hyundai Pavilion this Sunday at 1pm in honor of the firefighters who lost their lives during the Esperanza Fire. It is recommended that you delay your return trip to late afternoon or evening to avoid significant delays.
