STATE ROUTE 189 ROADWORK

San Bernardino Mountains – Caltrans will install recessed markers on State Route 189 (SR-189) between SR-18 and SR-173. The work will begin on Thursday, November 6, and is expected to be complete by November 21, weather permitting.

During the process, flagging and pilot cars will be utilized to move traffic through the construction zone. The work hours are 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. Monday through Friday.

Recessed markers are used to separate traffic lanes and have reflectors to guide motorists. In areas that are prone to snow or inclement weather, recessed markers are used in lieu of raised markers because they are embedded into the pavement to allow snow plow access without damaging the marker.

To avoid delays, please take an alternate route if possible, or alter your travel times around the work hours. Road workers will be working close to traffic. Motorists are advised to have patience, slow down, and follow all instructions.
