



# FINAL PILE DRIVING OPERATIONS FOR 91 HOV PROJECT

## PACHAPPA RAILROAD BRIDGE

Beginning Tuesday, November 4, 2014, final pile driving operations will take place in the SR-91 median between 14th Street and Central Avenue to allow for the completion of the new Pachappa Railroad Bridge.

To support the bridge, steel beams will be driven into the soil to form the bridge foundation. The machines used to drive the beams/piles into the ground will generate noise and vibration.

This work is scheduled to be completed over a 10-day period - Tuesday, November 4 to Friday, November 14. During weekdays, work will only take place at night, between the hours of 9 p.m. and 5 a.m., due to lane closure restrictions. During the weekend, work will take place day and night, beginning at 9 p.m. on Friday, November 7 and continuing through 5 a.m. on Monday, November 10. Working through the weekend will help to reduce nightly noise impacts to the community by allowing construction crews to complete this work approximately 10 nights sooner than originally scheduled.

During work hours, one lane will be closed in each direction of SR-91 between 14th Street and Central Avenue.

We apologize for any inconvenience this may cause you, but pile driving is required for this type of bridge structure.
