I-15 CLOSURES COMING YOUR WAY AT MOJAVE DRIVE INTERCHANGE

Victorville – Bridgework on the Mojave Drive interchange in Victorville will require some nighttime directional closures of Interstate 15 (I-15) for bridgework. The northbound I-15 will close on Monday evening, November 5, from 10:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m. on Tuesday morning, November 6. The southbound I-15 will close on Tuesday evening from 9:00 p.m. to Wednesday morning at 5:00 a.m., November 7.

Freeway traffic will be diverted off the freeway at Mojave Drive and right back on. Detours will be available for local traffic since Mojave Drive will be closed over the I-15 during the work hours. Please add a little extra time if you plan to drive through this area to allow for some minor delays.

Regular work throughout the project will require intermittent lane and ramp closures. Daytime work takes place Monday through Friday from 6:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Nighttime work is usually Sunday through Friday from 9:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m.

The City of Victorville funded the two-year \$8 million project, which began in early June 2007. The construction will improve the existing interchange by adding a new bridge to make four lanes (two in each direction), reconfigure the on and off ramps, and signalize the intersecting ramps.
