## **UPDATE ON STATE ROUTE 38 PAVING PROJECT**

**SAN BERNARDINO-** Caltrans and All American Asphalt are still working to complete the last portion of the pavement rehabilitation project on State Route 38 (SR 38) between the passing lanes and Rainbow Lane. The project resumed work in October after it was suspended due to the nesting period of an endangered bird called the Southwestern Willow Fly Catcher.

The contractor will work this **Saturday, November 7, from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.** to expedite paving while temperatures are favorable. **One way traffic control will be in effect** on Saturday and for the duration of the project, which is expected to be completed by the end of November (weather dependent).

**Motorists are advised to plan ahead and try to avoid the work by taking alternate routes to Big Bear, such as SR 330 or SR 18 (front or backside). The delays on SR 38 should last approximately 15 minutes.** Just a reminder that the flagging on SR 38 at Hathaway Creek Bridge ended on Monday, November 2.
