Interstate 15 (I-15) Sierra Avenue Interchange Project to Begin

FONTANA—The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will begin a project to widen and signalize the exit ramps at the I-15/Sierra Avenue Interchange on Wednesday, November 12, 2014. The project is estimated to be complete in February 2015.

The \$2.5 million project, which was awarded to All American Asphalt Company, Inc. of Corona, will signalize the northbound and southbound I-15 ramp intersections at Sierra Avenue in Fontana. It will also widen Sierra Avenue from one lane to two lanes from Riverside Avenue to north of the southbound I-15 off-ramp, perform drainage improvements, widen the northbound and southbound off-ramps, as well as extend the existing Sierra Avenue sewer line and taper Sierra Avenue from two lanes to one lane at Riverside Avenue.

The following is the schedule for the ramp closures:

Southbound	Monday thru Thursday	8 p.m. to 4 a.m.

	Saturday and Sunday	11 p.m. to 6 a.m.

Please keep in mind that the work on the southbound ramps will take place in November and December and that no two consecutive ramps will be closed at the same time. The northbound ramp work is yet to be determined.

Detours will be in place at all times, so please follow all posted signs. Motorists may also consider using alternate routes when available.
