



Construction Activities Suspended in observance of Veterans Day



In observance of Veterans day, construction work will be suspended Thursday-Saturday, November 10-12, 2016. Construction activities will resume on Monday, November 14, 2016.

Newport Road Bridge Nears Completion

Reconstruction of the south side of the bridge will continue through late November. Crews have completed the final concrete pours and falsework removal for the new eastbound lanes on the Newport Road bridge.

The next phase will open the south side of the bridge, providing two through lanes of traffic in each direction. Work has been steadily progressing toward the closure pour that will join the north and south decks of the new bridge. This closure, scheduled for the beginning of December, will mark the last major task that will be completed on the bridge. For the safety of the crews and the traveling public, intermittent ramp and lane closures will continue to facilitate preparations for the closure pour.

Please plan ahead in anticipation of the temporary increased traffic in this area. If possible, please avoid the project corridor and use an alternate route. Motorists and pedestrians should slow down and use caution when traveling through work zones, near barricades and equipment.
