WORK CONTINUES ON I-10 AND I-215 IN SAN BERNARDINO

San Bernardino– Caltrans continues the \$11.5 million project to install a fiber communications network on I-10 and I-215. Beginning Tuesday, November 13th, lane and ramp closures will occur in the San Bernardino and Grand Terrace area. Please refer to the chart below for dates and locations:

Westbound I-10 between I-215 and California St.	Tues., November 13 to Thurs., November 15	9 PM to 5 AM	Number 4 lane closure and alternating ramp closures
Northbound I-215 between Barton Road and Iowa Ave.	Tues., November 13 to Thurs., November 15	9 PM to 6 AM	Number 3 lane closure and alternating ramp closures
Southbound I-215 between Barton Road and Iowa Ave.	Monday, May 14 to Thursday, May17	10 PM to 5 AM	Alternating ramp closures

Anticipate the lane closures. Develop an alternate route in case a ramp closure is in effect. Consecutive ramps will not be closed at the same time. Signs will be posted to advise and direct motorists. As delays are anticipated, please allow extra time for your commute or consider using an alternate route.

Caltrans would like to thank motorists for their patience and support as we work to improve your roads. To avoid rear end collisions merge early and allow distance between you and the car in front of you. Caltrans asks that all advisory signs be obeyed and that you **SLOW FOR THE CONE ZONE**.
