Lane Reductions Continue on Newport Road for Roadway Widening Activities

Night work on eastbound and westbound Newport Road between Haun Road and Antelope Road will continue intermittently at night **Monday-Tuesday, November 16-20** from 9pm-6am and **Friday-Saturday, November 20-21** from 10pm-7:30am for roadway widening.

Please be advised that lanes will temporarily be reduced to one lane in each direction and the left turn pocket will be closed at night.


Lane Reductions on I-215 at Newport Road

Motorists driving on northbound and southbound I-215 will experience reconfigured traffic lanes at Newport Road. Lanes will be reduced from three lanes down to two lanes under the bridge beginning on **November 13, 2015** and continuing for approximately three months.

In this new configuration, the northbound and southbound on-ramps at Newport Road will have a dedicated lane merging onto the interstate for better traffic flow. In addition, the northbound and southbound off-ramps at Newport Road will have a dedicated lane to exit the freeway.

Please plan ahead in anticipation of the temporary increased traffic in this area. If possible, please avoid the project corridor and use an alternate route. Motorists and pedestrians should slow down and use caution when traveling through work zones, near barricades and equipment.
