## **Caltrans Paving Project on State Route 60/Interstate 215 and State Route 91 Update #1**

**Riverside** – Thursday night, Caltrans will begin paving from Interstate 215 at Columbia Avenue to SR-91 just south of the 60/91/215 interchange. Please see the schedule below.

Thursday, November 20	Eastbound SR-91 from just south of the 60/91/215 interchange to Northbound I-215 at Columbia Ave.	Full Closure	9:30 p.m. – 4:30 a.m.
Friday, November 21	Southbound I-215 from Columbia Ave. to SR-91 just south of the 60/91/215 interchange	Full Closure	11:00 p.m. – 7:00 a.m.

### **Thursday Night Detours**

Eastbound SR-91: Motorists will be detoured to the 60/215. From here, exit at Blaine Street, turn left at Iowa Avenue, and then left at Columbia Avenue. Then merge onto northbound Interstate 215.

Northbound Interstate 215: Exit at Blaine Street, turn left at Iowa Avenue, and then left at Columbia Avenue. From Columbia, merge back on northbound Interstate 215.

### **Friday Night Detours**

Southbound Interstate 215/Westbound SR-91: Exit southbound Interstate 215 at Columbia Avenue and turn right on Columbia. Take a left at Main Street to the eastbound SR-60 on-ramp. Then merge onto westbound SR-91 or southbound Interstate 215.

Caltrans plans to complete the project by the end of December. However, because the work is sensitive to temperature changes and wet weather, this schedule may change. If the temperature drops too low, the above work may be cancelled. We will keep you updated on lane closures for the duration of the roadwork.
