Emergency Project—King’s Stormwater Channel on State Route 86 (SR-86)

Salton Sea – An emergency project to repair a damaged section of the bridge of the King’s Stormwater Channel on State Route 86 (SR-86) will begin this weekend.

The \$581,000 emergency project will put a steel plate over the damaged section and place corrugated metal decking on the entire deck. The bridge was built as an experimental structure with a glass fiber reinforced polymer and fiber reinforced polymer composite girders. The bridge is exhibiting minor distress, but the emergency project will protect the structure from future distress.

The contractor will switch traffic from the #2 lane to the #1 lane this Saturday, November 23, 2013 from 7:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. in order to prepare for the project. During this time period, a traffic break may be needed in order to reset k-rail, as well as restripe the new configuration. The maximum delay is expected to be 30 minutes.

The project is expected to be completed by the beginning of December 2013 weather permitting.
