REVISION **STATE ROUTE 330 FINAL WORK**

San Bernardino County – Caltrans is close the completing the State Route 330 (SR-330) slope rehabilitation project. Some final work is required on the roadbed above the slope at the upper limits of the project. Therefore, a couple of nighttime closures will be necessary. Caltrans made the decision to delay this work until after the Thanksgiving holiday to allow motorists full access to SR-330.

SR-330 will close with no escorts on Monday evening, November 27, at 8:00 p.m. through Tuesday morning, November 28, at 5:30 a.m. It will close again on Tuesday evening, November 28, at 8:00 p.m. through Wednesday morning, November 29, at noon. If the work is completed sooner, SR-330 may open before noon on November 29.

SR-330 will remain under flagging or pilot car escort during the non-closure hours. The project is expected to be complete by December 7, 2006.

When you come to a highway work zone, watch out for workers. Drivers cutting in or suddenly changing lanes at the last minute may cause rear-end collisions, which are the most common type of crash in work zones.
