



No Closures During Thanksgiving Holiday

In observance of the Thanksgiving Day holiday, there will be no regularly scheduled daytime or nighttime closures starting **Wednesday, November 23, 2016 through Saturday, November 26, 2016.** Nighttime closures will resume on Monday, November 28, 2016.

Intermittent Closures for Ramp and Bridge Construction

Date/Time	Location/Details
November 21-22 Monday-Tuesday 7pm-8pm	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Temporary stop signs at Newport Road and southbound/northbound I-215 off-ramps due to signals being turned off for stage change. <i>Expect delays.</i>
November 21-22 Monday-Tuesday 8pm-6am	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Intermittent ramp closures on southbound/northbound I-215 on- and off-ramps

**If weather delays work on Monday night, construction will resume on Tuesday night.*

Nighttime Full Freeway and Newport Road Bridge Closures

Crews will be working on the Newport Road bridge over the I-215 freeway lanes. For the safety of the traveling public, these activities will require nighttime full closures of the northbound and southbound freeway lanes at Newport Road to avoid working over live traffic. Lane reductions will occur **Monday-Wednesday, November 28-30, from 10pm-5am.**

Traffic on Newport Road will be diverted to use Scott Road. Signage will be present to direct motorists, cyclists and pedestrians. Please follow the signed detour routes.

Please plan ahead in anticipation of the temporary increased traffic in this area. If possible, please avoid the project corridor and use an alternate route. Motorists and pedestrians should slow down and use caution when traveling through work zones, near barricades and equipment.
