Interstate 40 Bridge Work Continues

San Bernardino County – Caltrans continues work on Interstate 40 (I-40) to repair girders on eight bridges. The work consists of installing shear keys to stop/delay progression of girder cracks.

Beginning December 1st, the long-term lane restriction will be located on the westbound I-40 from the Essex overcrossing to the Rojo Bridge. One lane will be available across the bridges. **PLEASE NOTE:** The one lane available will provide for a 16' width. Any oversize loads should contact Caltrans Transportation Permits at (909) 383-4637. In order to keep you moving and on time, we have provided the work schedule below.
