



I-10 Tippecanoe Interchange Improvement Project, Phase I

Loma Linda, CA – As part of the I-10 Tippecanoe Interchange Improvement Project, Phase I, construction crews conducted a **Full Closure of the eastbound I-10 Tippecanoe Ave./Anderson St. off-ramp and the eastbound I-10 Waterman Ave. on-ramp** that began on Friday, November 22 at 10:00 PM and was scheduled to conclude Monday, November 25 at 6:00 AM . Unfortunately, due to delays that occurred in the field, we were unable to make the 6:00 a.m. opening. The Waterman Ave on-ramp was reopened on Monday, November 25 at 6:45 a.m. and the Tippecanoe Ave./Anderson St. off-ramp was reopened on Monday, November 25 at 8:40 a.m. We apologize for any inconvenience this may have caused and we thank you for your continued patience.

However, the work completed on the eastbound Tippecanoe Avenue off-ramp has many long-awaited benefits motorists can now enjoy. As you start to drive this off-ramp, you'll notice there is one lane that ties into four new turn lanes. Motorists will now have access to two left turn lanes, one of which doubles as a lane that traverses straight, and two dedicated right turn lanes.

On the horizon, additional work and improvements are planned for the Tippecanoe Avenue off-ramp. On Saturday, December 21, 2013, a short-term closure will take place from 7:00 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. Construction activities will include adding an additional lane to complement the existing lane. These two lanes will ultimately tie into the four new lanes. Construction activities during this stage will be monitored very closely and every precaution will be taken to ensure a timely opening. Completion of this work will ultimately increase traffic throughput and will alleviate queuing of vehicles on Interstate 10 making for a more efficient, safer route to travel.
