INTERSTATE 10 DESERT CENTER PAVEMENT REHABILITATION PROJECT

RIVERSIDE – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) continues work on the \$95 million Interstate 10 (I-10) Pavement Rehabilitation Project. The project will rehabilitate 124 lane miles of pavement in both directions of I-10 between Cactus City and State Route 177 (SR-177) junction.

Pavement work will be on eastbound I-10 between Cactus City Rest Area and the SR-177 junction. The eastbound I-10 will be down to **ONE** lane Monday through Friday.

The details of work for **December 1 to December 31, 2016** are as follows:
