DEVORE 2 – ROADWORK UPDATE

San Bernardino County – Caltrans continues work on the Devore 2 pavement rehabilitation project on Interstate 15 below the Cajon Pass. The contractor will install drainage dikes on three ramps throughout the project limits all day tomorrow, Thursday, November 30. The following ramps will be subject to intermittent closure from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

- ⚡⚡ Sierra Avenue on & off ramps
- ⚡⚡ Glen Helen Parkway on & off ramps
- ⚡⚡ Kenwood Avenue on & off ramps

The work will close one ramp at a time for approximately thirty minutes. The ramp closures will begin in the northbound direction of I-15 and then reverse in the southbound direction.

As a reminder, the next weekend work is scheduled to begin on **Friday, December 8 at 9:00 p.m.** and continue to Monday, December 11, at 3:00 a.m. Reference Closure E on our website or in the brochure. Closure E involves work at one connector as follows:

Closed:

- ⚡⚡ Friday evening (9 pm), December 8 to Monday morning (3 am), December 11:
 - Northbound I-215 connector to northbound I-15

Detour during the connector closure:

For northbound I-215 travelers – Use I-15 north to avoid the connector closure.

Night work will continue to take place Monday through Sunday from 6 p.m. to approximately 6 a.m. The project is expected to be complete in early 2007. Caltrans advises motorists to avoid the construction or travel before or after the work hours. If possible, take an alternate route.
