



Four-Day Closure Planned In Early December For State Route 111, East of Salton Sea

Caltrans is replacing an old bridge on a portion of State Route 111 in the vicinity east of the Salton Sea. SR-111 will be closed to traffic during this work between the communities of Niland in the south and Mecca to the north on:

Friday, Dec. 7 starting at 7 a.m.
through
Tuesday, Dec. 11, at 7 a.m.

Because this is a stretch of highway without easily-accessible parallel roads, traffic will be detoured from the north and south to the west side of the Salton Sea along SR-86. Add additional time to your travel to accommodate this detour.

Highway signs reading "Road Closed to Thru Traffic" are in place. Bombay Beach area residents, business owners and customers will still have access by using SR-111 north to/from Mecca during the closure.
