PERMIT WORK ON 395 MAY CAUSE DELAYS

Victorville – Caltrans is alerting the public that a permit project to do pothole work on Route 395 will begin on Thursday, December 6, and continue through December 20. The work hours are 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Monday through Friday with intermittent traffic control.

The work will take place between Bear Valley Road and Villa Street. Some of the project limits take place on the four-lane section of Route 395 while the other limits are in the two-lane section. Only one lane will be available for passing in the two-lane section. Be advised that flaggers will be on scene to move traffic through the construction area. Please try and plan your travel outside of the work hours or take an alternate route to avoid delays.

Recently a Caltrans worker was killed doing his job on a local state highway in San Bernardino County. Caltrans asks the public to please slow down and give the construction workers your complete attention. Hang up your cell phone and drive carefully through the construction area.
