EL CERRITO BRIDGE SCHEDULED FOR DEMOLITION

RIVERSIDE – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will begin demolition on the El Cerrito Bridge on Monday, December 10th. The demolition is expected to take approximately one week. A full freeway closure is necessary for the safety of motorists and workers during the time of demolition.

El Cerrito will no longer be available to motorists to get on and off the freeway and will not be reconstructed. With the completion of the newly construction Martin Luther King Boulevard Intersection motorists will have a better access to the freeway in both the north and southbound directions of the 215/60.

NB 215-WB 60:

Exit off the freeway at Central, left onto Central Avenue, right onto Canyon Crest, right onto Martin Luther King Boulevard, proceed under the freeway, left onto NB 215-WB 60.

SB215-EB 60:

Exit off the freeway at Martin Luther King Boulevard, right onto Martin Luther King Boulevard, left onto Canyon Crest, left onto Central Avenue, right onto SB 215-EB 60.
