WHAT: Nighttime lane reductions will occur for crews for striping.

Nightly, 11:00 p.m. – 4:00 a.m., Monday, December 10 – Friday, December 14	Closure of EB and WB 91 Express Lanes

WHAT: Alternating, intermittent nighttime full ramp closures for ramp work and striping. Consecutive ramps will not be closed at the same time.
