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DEVORE 2 – NIGHTWORK MAY CAUSE DELAYS

San Bernardino County – Caltrans continues the Devore 2 pavement rehabilitation project on Interstate 15 below the Cajon Pass. Night work will continue throughout the project until its' completion in early 2007. The contractor is working on bridge approaches, which makes it necessary to reduce lanes down to one at times. The night work takes place between 6:00 p.m. and approximately 6:00 a.m. The southbound I-15 lanes are subject to being reduced at 6:00 p.m. and the northbound I-15 lanes begin reduction at 8:00 p.m.

Delays for nighttime commuters and motorists have been heavy over the last couple of weeks. In order to make your trip smoother, please take Interstate 10 east to Interstate 215 north and continue back to I-15 north.

Two more weekends of Rapid Rehab work are expected to take place in January 2007 (weather permitting). The closures are as follows:

- ✂✂ Closure D – will close southbound 215 at the 15 connector.
- ✂✂ Closure E – will close northbound 215 at the 15 connector.

These last two closures will have a moderate impact on traffic. Motorists will be diverted to I-15 as a detour for both closures. Use I-10 between the 15 and 215 as the detour for the 215.

Caltrans will give you a break for the holidays. To accommodate holiday travel, there will be no planned lane or ramp closures beginning Friday, December 22, at 6:00 a.m. through Tuesday, January 2, at 6:00 p.m. This includes the Devore 2 project and any other Caltrans construction or maintenance projects.
