**WHAT: STORM WATCH**

**WHEN: SUNDAY, DECEMBER 09, 2007 (1357)**

**WHERE: SAN BERNARDINO & RIVERSIDE COUNTIES**

Caltrans alerts motorists that recent wildfires have made some state highways vulnerable to rock slides and debris flow. Weather can change dramatically and road closures may take place without warning. Below is the update of road closures for the Inland Empire.

HIGHWAY	STATUS	CHAINS
SR-18, SR-138, SR-38 and SR-330	OPEN	REQUIRED
SR-243	OPEN	REQUIRED

**CHAINS ARE REQUIRED ON MOUNTAIN ROUTES IN RIVERSIDE AND SAN BERNARDINO COUNTIES; BE PREPARED AND BRING CHAINS.**

## CHAIN CONTROL REQUIREMENT LEVELS:

- W: **No Restrictions** - Watch for snow on pavement.
- R-1: Chains are required on all commercial vehicles (trucks or buses). All other vehicles (cars, pick-ups, vans, etc.) must have either snow tread tires or chains on the drive axle.
- R-2: Chains are required on all vehicles except four-wheel drives with snow tread tires. Four-wheel drive vehicles must carry chains in the vehicle.
- R-3: Chains required - ALL VEHICLES - no exceptions.
