Construction Activity, Redlands Ave./4th St. Ramp

CLOSURE UPDATE:

The Interstate 215 Project requires short-term full closures of the Redlands Avenue/4th Street ramps in Perris. The northbound off-ramp closure started at 1 a.m., December 8 and will re-open the early morning of December 12.

The southbound on-ramp closure was scheduled December 9-13. Due to weather, this work and ramp closure have been postponed. New closure dates for the southbound on-ramp closure will be provided in the coming weeks; please stay tuned!

The freeway speed limit has been reduced to 55 mph. The speed limit for Perris Blvd. has been reduced to 25 mph between Jarvis Street and San Jacinto Avenue. New speed limit signs have been posted. Please be aware that traffic fines increase in the construction zone.
