MAINTENANCE ROADWORK

Riverside/San Bernardino Counties – In an effort to minimize traffic impacts during holidays, Caltrans places a moratorium on lane closures. From Thursday, December 23, at 6:00 am until Tuesday, January 4, at 6:00 pm there are no planned lane closures. However, please be advised that emergency work with closures make take place throughout the moratorium.

Many roadwork projects in construction zones have reduced lanes along state highways throughout the Inland Empire. Crews may continue to work next to the highways over the holidays, without closures, evening inclement weather. Please be cautious as you drive, slow down in the work zones, and have patience. **Most importantly, please don't drink and drive.**

In an effort to keep you informed and to alert you of any maintenance roadwork that may cause delays, Caltrans provides a weekly update. The information below is not all maintenance work on state highways, but some work that you may want to avoid as you commute around the Inland Empire.

Work may be canceled due to inclement weather.
