**WHAT: STORM WATCH**

**WHEN: WEDNESDAY, DECEMBER 19, 2007 (1400)**

**WHERE: SAN BERNARDINO & RIVERSIDE COUNTIES**

Caltrans alerts motorists that due to inclement weather chain control or road closures may take place on state highways. Weather can change dramatically without warning so be aware and ready before you travel. Below is the update of road conditions for the Inland Empire.

**No chain control in effect at this time, however, bring chains when traveling to mountain areas in the event of inclement weather.**

SR-2 from west of Big Pines to San Bern Co. Line	CHAIN CONTROL R-1	SNOW/ICE	UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE
SR-18 from Green Valley Rd. to Big Bear Dam	CHAIN CONTROL R-2	SNOW/ICE	UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE
SR-38 from Heart Bar to Hatchery Drive	CHAIN CONTROL R-2	SNOW/ICE	UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE
SR-330 from Lower Passing Lane to Running Springs	CHAIN CONTROL R-2	SNOW/ICE	UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE

**CHAIN CONTROL REQUIREMENT LEVELS:**

- W: **No Restrictions** - Watch for snow on pavement.
- R-1: Chains are required on all commercial vehicles (trucks or buses). All other vehicles (cars, pick-ups, vans, etc.) must have either snow tread tires or chains on the drive axle.
- R-2: Chains are required on all vehicles except four-wheel drives with snow tread tires. Four-wheel drive vehicles must carry chains in the vehicle.
- R-3: Chains required - ALL VEHICLES - no exceptions.
