NIGHTTIME FULL FREEWAY, CONNECTOR, RAMP AND LANE CLOSURES ON I-15 AND I-215 IN DEVORE – DECEMBER 20 TO DECEMBER 23, 2014

DEVORE, Calif. – As part of the Devore Interchange Project, crews will conduct activities that will necessitate full freeway, connector, ramp and alternating lane closures for the safety of the public and workers. Following are details of construction activities that will begin on Saturday night, December 20 and end on Tuesday morning, December 23, 2014. Most closure restrictions will be lifted each day so motorists can travel at peak daytime traffic times. Noise can be expected with these activities. Please note that information contained in this commuter alert is subject to change without notice based on weather, field conditions or other operational factors.
