Mon., Dec. 20 - Tues., Dec. 21 8 p.m. to 6 a.m.	<b>FULL NB I-215 AT 2ND STREET</b>	<u>NB I-215:</u> Drivers will exit at 2nd St. and turn right, turn left on G St., which turns into H St. Head north and re-enter NB I-215 using the 10th St. northbound I-215 on-ramp.
Sun., Dec. 19 - Tues., Dec. 21 7 p.m. to <b>TBD</b>	SB I-215 Orange St. On-Ramp	<u>SB I-215 Orange St. On-Ramp:</u> Drivers will travel south on H St., turn right on 2nd St., and use the 2nd St. on-ramp to access SB I-215.
Sun., Dec. 19 - Tues., Dec. 21 7 p.m. to <b>TBD</b>	NB I-215 2nd St. On-Ramp	<u>NB I-215 2nd St. On-Ramp:</u> Drivers will travel north on G/H St. and access NB I-215 using the 10th St. on-ramp.
Sun., Dec. 19 - Tues., Dec. 21 7 p.m. to <b>TBD</b>	NB I-215 #1 and 2 lanes between 2nd and 5th streets	No detour during the day but full closure at night.
Sun., Dec. 19 - Tues., Dec. 21 7 p.m. to <b>TBD</b>	SB I-215 #1 and 2 lanes between 3rd and 2nd streets	No detour necessary as at least one lane is expected to remain open.

Starting April 2, 2010 for two years	27th St./Mt. Vernon Ave. SB on-ramp and NB off-ramp
Starting December 2009 until 2013	SB I-215 Baseline St. off-ramp
Starting January 2010 for two years	NB Highland Avenue on- and off-ramps
Starting January 2010 until late 2010	Full closure of 9th St. bridge
Starting October 2009 until new 5 <sup>th</sup> St. ramps are constructed	Permanent closure of 4th St. on-ramps for new 5th St. ramps
