SR-18 from Green Valley Rd to Big Bear Dam	Closed	Mudslide	Unknown
SR-38 from Camp Angelus to Lake Williams	Reopened following mudslide	R2 Chain Requirements	May change at any time due to inclement weather
SR 173 from Summit Valley SR 138 to Arrowhead Lake Road	Closed	Flooding	Unknown
SR 2 Islip Saddle in LA County to 5 miles west of Big Pines	Closed	Rock/Mud slides and snow	Long-term closure

Please remember to carry chains in your vehicle if you travel to mountain areas. Changes in weather or road conditions happen quickly.

CHAIN CONTROL REQUIREMENT LEVELS:

W: **No Restrictions** - Watch for snow on pavement.
 R-1: Chains are required on all commercial vehicles (trucks or buses). All other vehicles (cars, pick-ups, vans, etc.) must have either snow tread tires or chains on the drive axle.
 R-2: Chains are required on all vehicles except four-wheel drives with snow tread tires. Four-wheel drive vehicles must carry chains in the vehicle.
 R-3: Chains required - ALL VEHICLES - no exceptions.
