

Night Operations Suspended During the Holidays



In observance of the Christmas and New Year's Eve holidays, there will be **no regularly scheduled nighttime closures** at the on- and off-ramps, Newport Road between Haun Road and Antelope Road, as well as the I-215 freeway lanes at Newport Road starting **Wednesday, December 23, 2015 through Sunday, January 3, 2016**. Regularly scheduled nighttime closures will resume on Monday, January 4, 2016.

I-215 Southbound Off-Ramp Completed

As part of the projects Stage 1, the new southbound off-ramp is scheduled to be open to the public on **Tuesday, December 22**. This will give way to the new northbound loop on-ramp that is anticipated to be completed in the Spring 2016.

Please expect some delays while configuration for the traffic signal at the intersection is completed on Tuesday, December 22.


Lane Reductions Continue on Newport Road for Roadway Widening Activities

Night work on eastbound and westbound Newport Road between Haun Road and Antelope Road will continue intermittently at night **Monday, December 21** from 9pm-6am and **Tuesday-Thursday from 10-pm-6am, December 22-24** for storm drain installation and roadway widening.

Please be advised that lanes will temporarily be reduced to one lane in each direction and the left turn pocket will be closed at night.

Please plan ahead in anticipation of the temporary increased traffic in this area. If possible, please avoid the project corridor and use an alternate route. Motorists and pedestrians should slow down and use caution when traveling through work zones, near barricades and equipment.
