CHAIN CONTROL MAY DROP TO LOWER ELEVATIONS –

BRING YOUR CHAINS!

SR-38 from Angelus Oaks to Big Bear Dam (Angelus Oaks to Fawnskin, Big Bear)	R-2	Snow	Unknown
SR-138 from SR-18 to Crest Forest Drive (Crestline)	R-2	Snow	Unknown
SR-189 from SR-18 to SR-173 (Blue Jay, Twin Peaks, Lake Arrowhead)	R-2	Snow	Unknown
SR-330 from Middle Pass to Running Springs	R-2	Snow	Unknown
SR-74 from Hemet to Mountain Center	R-2	Snow	Unknown
SR-243 from SR-74 to Pine Cove (to Idyllwild)	R-1	Snow	Unknown

CHAIN CONTROL REQUIREMENT LEVELS:

- W: **No Restrictions** - Watch for snow on pavement.
- R-1: Chains are required on all commercial vehicles (trucks or buses). All other vehicles (cars, pick-ups, vans, etc.) must have either snow tread tires or chains on the drive axle.
- R-2: Chains are required on all vehicles except four-wheel drives with snow tread tires. Four-wheel drive vehicles must carry chains in the vehicle.
- R-3: Chains required - ALL VEHICLES - no exceptions.
