| SR-18 from Heaps Peak to Smarts Ranch Rd (ROTW to Lucerne) | R-2 | Snow | Unknown |
| SR-38 from Angelus Oaks to Big Bear Dam (Angelus Oaks to Fawnskin, Big Bear) | R-2 | Snow | Unknown |
| SR-189 from SR-18 to SR-173 (Blue Jay, Twin Peaks, Lake Arrowhead) | R-1 | Snow | Unknown |
| <u>SR-330 from Lower Pass to Running Springs</u> | R-2 | Snow | Unknown |
| SR-74 from Hemet to Mountain Center | R-2 | Snow | Unknown |
| SR-2 from Vincents Gap to Islip Saddle | CLOSED | Snow | Unknown |

CHAIN CONTROL REQUIREMENT LEVELS:

- W: **No Restrictions** - Watch for snow on pavement.
- R-1: Chains are required on all commercial vehicles (trucks or buses). All other vehicles (cars, pick-ups, vans, etc.) must have either snow tread tires or chains on the drive axle.
- R-2: Chains are required on all vehicles except four-wheel drives with snow tread tires. Four-wheel drive vehicles must carry chains in the vehicle.
- R-3: Chains required - ALL VEHICLES - no exceptions.
