




I-215 WIDENING PROJECT

Ramp Opening & Closures Notification

Beginning January 3, 2012



As part of the Interstate 215 Widening Project, there will be two closures and one opening of a ramp to allow construction crews to continue work through the corridor. Details of the activities are included below. As a reminder, please drive at safe speeds and leave appropriate braking distances while traveling through the corridor.

Ramp Opening

Southbound I-215 5th Street On-Ramp: Will open to motorists on **Thursday, January 12, 2012.**

Ramps Closing

Southbound SR-259 Baseline Street Off-Ramp: Scheduled to close permanently on **Tuesday, January 3, 2012.** NOTE: A direct southbound SR-259 off-ramp to the Baseline Street bridge will be built.

Detour: Travel southbound to I-215 and exit 5th Street. Turn left and continue to H Street. Turn left at H Street and travel north to Baseline Street.

Southbound I-215 Baseline Street On-Ramp: Scheduled to close permanently on **Thursday, January 12, 2012.** NOTE: A direct on-ramp from the Baseline Street bridge to southbound I-215 will be built.

Detour: Travel southbound on H Street and turn right on 5th Street. Enter southbound I-215 on the new 5th Street on-ramp.
