SR 2 Islip Saddle in LA County to 5 miles west of Big Pines	Closed	Rock/Mud slides and snow	Long-term closure
SR 18 From Kuffel Canyon Rd to SR 173 (Sky Forest Area)	Closed	Road failure	Unknown
SR 18 from Green Valley Rd to Big Bear Dam	Closed	Mudslide	Unknown
SR18 Sheep Creek Road (Pinon Hills) to SR138/SR18 (Llano)	Closed	Flooding/Mud flow	Unknown
SR 83 (Euclid Ave) from Pine St to SR 71 (Chino)	Closed	Flooding	Unknown

Please remember to carry chains in your vehicle if you travel to mountain areas. Changes in weather or road conditions happen quickly.

CHAIN CONTROL REQUIREMENT LEVELS:

- W: **No Restrictions** - Watch for snow on pavement.
- R-1: Chains are required on all commercial vehicles (trucks or buses). All other vehicles (cars, pick-ups, vans, etc.) must have either snow tread tires or chains on the drive axle.
- R-2: Chains are required on all vehicles except four-wheel drives with snow tread tires. Four-wheel drive vehicles must carry chains in the vehicle.
- R-3: Chains required - ALL VEHICLES - no exceptions.
