## **FLYOVER CONNECTOR RAMPS AT 60/91/215 OPENED TO MOTORIST**

**RIVERSIDE** – On Monday, December 24<sup>th</sup>, California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) opened both the northwest and southeast connector ramps located at the heart of the 60/91/215 Interchange. It was previously anticipated the connector ramps would not be available to motorists until December 27<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup>. However, with a concerted effort from everyone involved, both connector ramps were opened by 8:00 a.m. this morning.

Signage has been posted to alert motorists to the availability of the connector ramps, but because motorists are accustomed to using the old connector loops, a grace period will be available where the old connector loops will remain open to motorists. Caltrans also anticipates using the old connector loops as detours for work on the remainder of the interchange. It is possible that the old connector loops will remain open until late January 2008.

Caltrans would like to thank motorists for their continued patience and support during the 60/91/215 improvement project. Caltrans also would like to thank the California Highway Patrol for their tireless effort to assist with the on-going construction. Safety for motorists and those building our freeways is a top priority. We ask that motorists please be aware of the construction area and always make a point to ***SLOW FOR THE CONE ZONE.***
