Interstate 10 (I-10) Concrete Median Barrier Project in Palm Desert

PALM DESERT—The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will continue work next week to construct a concrete median barrier and widen the outside shoulder on I-10 between Monterey Avenue and Washington Street. The \$3.2 million project will reduce the severity of collisions. The project was awarded to Chumo Construction of Baldwin Park, Calif.

Crews will work during nighttime hours. The project is expected to be finished by mid-May 2014 (weather permitting). The work for next week will take place as follows below:
